Self check feature








- Borrow or return books using your smartphone
- No need to visit the library desk or self-service kiosk



- Click the SELF
 CHECK button in the app
- Next, click on the green CHECK-OUT icon to borrow books




- All books have a RFID tag, usually located inside the back cover
- On DVDs and some other items, the tag may be a clear sticker on one of the discs




The phone uses NFC (near field communication) to read the tag.




- Hold the phone next to the book, as close to the tag as possible
- Most phones can read the tags within 4-5 centimeters




- Once it reads the tag, you will get a blue tick mark
- The book is now on your account.
 Click CLOSE to scan your next item or to finish




When you click FINISH you will get a confirmation screen showing the number of items borrowed.



If you get an error screen, bring the item to the desk where a member of staff can help.




- Each library has a designated check-in zone where you can return books
- Once you are in this zone, open the app and click CHECK-IN




Hold the phone next to the book, as close to the tag as possible


The phone will read the tag and remove the book from your account




Click on SCAN A LIBRARY ITEM to return the next book.



Place the checked-in books in the returns bin/trolley.



Once all items are returned, click FINISH and you will get a confirmation screen.




Troubleshooting

- NFC must also be turned on




Troubleshooting
