Fernhill Park Experience is an interactive, educational augmented reality (AR) game based on the new Fernhill Park and Gardens in Stepaside. Designed by students at IADT, the smartphone app uses AR technology to display visualisations of the park and a map of Fernhill has been designed to pair with the AR tool. The player will explore and learn about the topics of rewilding, reforestation and renewable energy, and can make real-time changes to the park based around these topics. The player then

chooses a final scenario for Fernhill and will learn about the future impact of their decision.

## Regattas in Kingstown/Dún Laoghaire




## 3 August – 30 September 2023 Level 3, dir Lexicon
