WELCOME TO DUNDRUM LIBRARY

Here's a quick guide to using the library and the services that are available!

The library doesn't only have books! We also have DVDs, games, physical audiobooks and CDs and lots of great events!

You can have up to 12 items at a time and the borrowing period is 3 weeks! You can also renew items online , in person or over the phone up to 5 times once there isn't a reservation on the item.

Irish libraries are now fine free and you can use your card to borrow and return items in any public library in Ireland!

Study Spaces are available upstairs on a first come first served basis. Events happen through out the year that may result in full or partial closure of the space. A calendar to check the availability of the space can be found in branch.

The public wifi is dlr members and the log in is your library card number and pin!

Library cards expire every year and can be renewed online, over the phone or in a branch.

If your local branch doesn't have a book you're looking for you can order it through the website, with staff when you're in a branch or over the phone. To search the catalogue or renew loans online you can log in by you using the long number on the back of your card and the four digit pin you would have set up while registering. The library also has loads of online resources particularly for children! <u>Borrowbox</u> and <u>Libby</u> both have e-books and audiobooks for kids and the following services are aimed especially at kids!

<u>TumbleBookLibrary</u> is an online collection of ebooks for children. You can use your computer, tablet, or mobile phone, all you need is an Internet connection. <u>LOTE4Kids</u> is a library eResource that allows kids to learn a language and connect with books through the magic of storytelling. You can choose from thousands of audio-picture books in 50+ languages, together with English translations.

<u>Moshi</u> is the latest free online resource from dlr Libraries with hundreds of original and inspiring audio stories and music to capture your child's imagination, help them sleep faster and unlock their potential. Register at <u>https://app.moshikids.com/library/dlr</u> to start, copy the code, download the app and login to access for 30 days. You can set up a profile for up to 3 children and log in on 3 separate devices. When your month is up, simply come back to the above link and login to renew access for another 30 days (all for free!)

Borrowbox and Libby are our partners for audiobooks and ebooks and are available through apps and web browsers. To log in you'll need your card number and four digit pin. Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown is your library when signing up.

<u>Kanopy</u> is our partner for movies and TV streaming and provides instant access to thousands of critically acclaimed movies, documentaries and shows for children. You will have 10 credits per month to watch movies, series, and documentaries and you can stream Kanopy on any of your favourite devices.

Our partner <u>Freegal</u> gives users access to over 15 million songs. Streaming is unlimited plus you can download and keep up to five songs every week. You can download music videos too, with each video counting as two out of your five weekly download allowance.

<u>Pressreader</u> is our partner for reading newspapers and magazines. You can access PressReader in the library using our wifi, on library PCs, on your smartphone with your browser or the PressReader app at home or anywhere!

<u>Universal Class</u> offers library patrons a unique online education experience and it's available free of charge to all dlr Library members. With a growing catalogue of over 400 courses you're sure to find something that meets your interests.

<u>Transparent Languages Online</u> empowers learners to explore a new language at the library, at home, or on the go using any Internet-connected device. Available in 110+ languages, including ESL, learners have the flexibility they need to learn a new

language anytime, anywhere.

Printing Instructions

Email your document as an attachment to the email above that suits your printing preference. Make sure that the subject line is not blank, if it is add a short text, e.g. "Email Print". Make sure it is different to the attached document name, so that you can distinguish the returned codes. Check your email, for a Release Code (can take 5 – 10 minutes to process). To retrieve your document at the PrintStation, enter the 6-digit Release Code and make payment when prompted.

Important Notes!

Make sure to choose the "Send a Copy" (or similar) option to send your document as an attachment, rather than a shared link.
Forwarding an existing email with attachments also won't work they must be attached to a new email and sent to the printer.
The following file formats are supported: Word, Excel, Powerpoint, PDF. Photos files such as PNG, JPEG, BMP, GIF, TIFF may print incorrectly and it's advised to convert them to PDF first.
