The most important domestic issue was that of Civil Rights which unleashed a rights revolution among the marginalised in the United States. From this January, on Tuesday evenings we will have: • Reduced lighting • Priority queuing for customers dealing with autism as well as extra assistance upon request • Self-service machine on silent • Phones quiet • Autism assistance dogs always welcome  
Our community can help us each Tuesday evening by: • Phones on silent and all calls taken outside the library • Speaking quietly • Chatting to children before any Tuesday evening visits to explain why the library is extra-quiet and how they can help • Remembering to avoid light-up toys or shoes on children • Letting the staff know any further way in which we can accommodate the autism community.

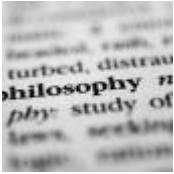
