

Code of Conduct for customers/users of dlr Libraries

Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council's Library Service seeks to provide you with the best possible service in a safe and secure environment. To achieve this, we expect that you treat staff and other library users in a courteous and respectful manner.

- The following conduct by customers/users of the Library is not acceptable:
 - a) Behaviour that is disruptive and interferes with the use and enjoyment of Library facilities by staff or customers/users.
 - b) Harassment of staff or customers/users through the use of offensive, obscene or threatening language, whether carried out in person on the Library premises, or electronically.
 - c) The use or threat of physical violence towards staff or customers/users, whether carried out in person on the Library premises, or electronically.
 - d) The photography or filming of staff or customers/users, on the Library premises, without their consent or permission.
 - e) Malicious damage to and/or theft of Library property.
 - f) The use of alcohol or unlawful drugs on the Library premises.
 - g) Smoking/vaping on Library premises.
 - h) Leaving personal property unattended on the Library premises.
 - i) Consuming food or drink on the Library premises, with the exception of bottled water.
- Customers/users in breach of this Code may have their access to the Library
 Service suspended. The periods of suspension will be at the discretion
 of dlr Libraries. Customers/users may be permanently suspended from the Service
 for serious or repeated breaches of this Code.
- Customers/users have 30 days to appeal any suspension imposed. The appeal should be made in writing for the attention of the County Librarian.
