What is a Reader Pen?

A Reader Pen is a device that reads words and full lines of text aloud for independent reading. The
ReaderPen also has an inbuilt dictionary: simply pass the pen across a word and it instantly displays the
definition of the word and reads it aloud. The Pen can also read Spanish and French text.

How can I borrow a Reader Pen?

• Email <u>libraryculture@dlrcoco.ie</u> with your library card number, and the dlr Library that you would like to collect the pen from. A member of staff will add you to the waitlist, and will contact you when the pen is available.

How long can I borrow a Reader pen for?

Reader pens can be borrowed for a period of 8 weeks.

What is included with the Reader Pen?

• The Reader Pen comes with a carry case, a cable to charge the reader pen and a quick start guide. You will find them underneath the ReaderPen in the box. Can I renew the Reader Pen?

 We operate a waitlist for the Reader Pens, so they cannot be renewed. If you wish to borrow the pen again, email <u>libraryculture@dlrcoco.ie</u> and we can add you to the waitlist again

Can my child borrow/use a Reader Pen?

Yes your child can use the pen, however, the pen must be issued onto an Adult Card

I live outside of the dlr area, can I borrow a Reader Pen?

• To borrow a pen you will need to collect the pen from a dlr Library, and return it only to a dlr Library. Email libraryculture@dlrcoco.ie and we can assist.
