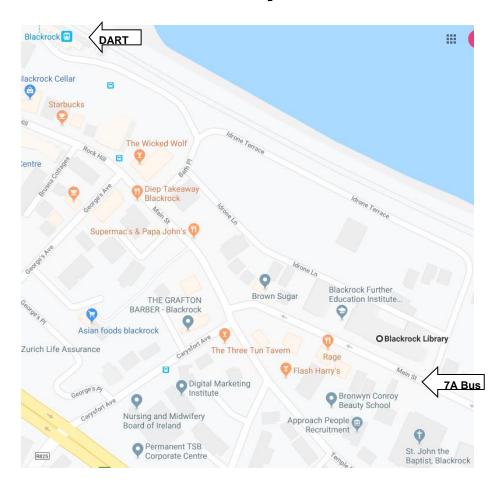

Sometimes it might be noisy and busy. If it is noisy, I can ask for help.



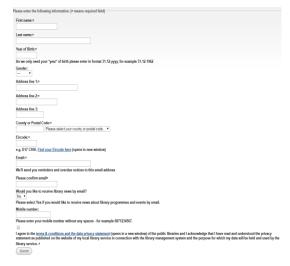
How to become a member of the library

I will show the librarian my photo identification. This can be a driving licence or passport



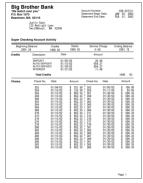




How to become a member of the library

There are sensory items for me to use while in the library. I can ask a member of staff for help.





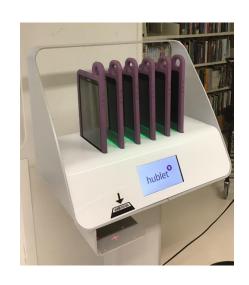
When I visit Blackrock Library
