For over a decade renowned author, photographer and creator of Humans of Dublin, Peter Varga, has roamed the streets of Dublin, capturing the essence of its residents through over 2,500 portraits and narratives. His work not only celebrates individual lives but also weaves a larger narrative that celebrates our shared humanity. This exhibition showcases 60 poignant portraits, including 10 special stories from the vibrant community of Dún Laoghaire, crafted exclusively for this occasion. Through his lens, Varga immortalises the beauty, diversity, and resilience of the people who call this city home.

This exhibition will tell the origins of the Dun Emer & Cuala Industries in Dundrum and Churchtown, the engagement between the Yeats family, but specifically Susan (Lily), and the pioneering figure of Evelyn Gleeson; elaborated through a series of visuals from original prints, the work of the many women artists who contributed to the Cuala portfolio, and present original works by the members of the Irish Guild of Embroiderers.

Marking the centenary publication of 'The Cat and the Moon' (Cuala, 1924) they have found inspiration within the themes of this W.B Yeats' work, while also reflecting the colour palette and skillful selection of stitches created by Susan (Lily) Yeats in completing her work.





Feast Upon the Earth is a big picture story depicting existence, Earth and humanity. The artwork is a large timescape 2.4 metres high, spanning 10 metres. It was originally commissioned by the Irish Museum of Modern Art as part of the Earth Rising eco-festival.

Feast Upon the Earth situates us in geological time, zooming in on human timeframes as we progress



The connection between the cosmos and humanity is shown. We are led to reflect on our place in the whole dynamic of existence, and ponder "What future will we choose?"

#### **ScanEZ Scanning Services**

dlr Libraries are delighted to introduce the ScanEZ service at three of our branches. ScanEZ is a multifunctional device which can be used for:

 High-speed scanning of documents with two types of scanner available – flatbed for larger documents and a sheet-fed scanner which can scan up to 120 pages per minute



- Restoring old photos and faded documents at the click of a button using built-in artificial intelligence (AI) technology
- Scanning hand-written documents and converting to Word format using the latest Al and optical character recognition (OCR)
- Translation services scan or import your document and translate into text or audio format. Over 100 languages available including Irish and Ukrainian
- Create Word or PDF documents from your files

You can then edit, print, save or email your newly created documents. The system has a multi-lingual interface and includes accessibility features for visually impaired users including screen narration. The ScanEZ service is currently available on Level 5, dlr LexIcon and in Blackrock and Dundrum Libraries.


