





Presented by the Peruvian Embassy in Ireland, this exhibition highlights the work of Issa Watanabe, one of the most recognised Latin American illustrators in recent years. Her book *Migrants*, published in Spain and in 18 countries, has received important distinctions, such as the Libreter Award (Barcelona, 2020) and the Gran Premio BIBF Ananas (Beijing, 2021). The artist's journey has a strong self-taught element: she began studying Literature at the Pontifical Catholic University of Peru, later resided in Mallorca, where she took some art courses, and then returned to the Peruvian capital to fully dedicate herself to her creative work.

"The first drawing I made was inspired by a series from photographer Magnus Wenman, who portrayed Syrian children sleeping in makeshift camps in the middle of the forest. The children's gaze reflected not only profound sadness but, above all, the terror they were experiencing. They have lost their homes, witnessed the atrocities of war, and endured extreme poverty; they have felt the suffering that comes with losing their parents or siblings in such a violent way, and there is no solace. What can I do but draw? At least, through a drawing, I can try to reach that forest" - Issa Watanabe

Curated by Professor Geraldine Higgins, Director of Irish Studies at Emory University, this exhibition was created in partnership between the NLI, the Department of Tourism, Culture, Arts, Gaeltacht, Sport and Media, and Bank of Ireland.

The Big House formed the private domain for generations of the political, military and financial elites of Ireland and while it was largely removed from the everyday experience of Irish men and women, it often stood at the centre of the local economy, providing employment for those living in the area. The world of the Big House became increasingly unsteady as Ireland tilted towards independence and the grand houses that survived the fires of the 1920s faced further change during the twentieth century. Many of them were adapted and changed for use as convents, hospitals and schools. This exhibition was originally curated by David Gunning, former dlr Historian in Residence.

The unique 'gamified' approach motivates students to learn how to touch type, by offering them word per minute badges, and they can earn new avatars or virtual coins, that can be used in the typing game arcade. A virtual coin used for each game is earned by the student's performance on the Typewiz course, motivating them to complete exercises quickly and accurately. Students can take breaks from

typing after each module and see reports on their progress. Reports and course certificates are available to print.

We also continue to offer TTRS

(Touch Type Read Spell) which is an award-winning, multi-sensory course that teaches typing, reading and spelling. It's highly accessible and recommended for users with dyslexia, ASD, or visual impairment. Also suitable for adults and mature learners who struggle with literacy.
